Downtown Clinton Construction Update Week of May 10th, 2021

Albert Street North

Starting May 10th, Albert Street will be under construction from Princess Street West going north. Project includes:

- Curb removal and replacement
- Pavement resurfacing

Repaving is scheduled to begin May 25, 2021 and is expected to be completed within one week, weather permitting. During the project one lane of traffic will remain open. Please be cautious of flag people.

Albert Street Reconstruction **Project 2021**

Huron County and Central Huron have awarded the contract to Lavis Contracting Company Ltd. The cost of the project is just under \$3.7 million.

Central Huron is pleased to share that Albert Street in Clinton will be receiving an extensive facelift this summer, starting early June, and finishing mid-November. During this time, Albert Street will be closed from Princess Street W. to Highway 8.

Some of the work being completed is:

- Enbridge will be replacing the gas mains and services from Hwy #8 to Princess Street. This work has already started.
- Replacement of storm sewer, sanitary sewers, watermain, concrete curbs and sidewalks, street lighting, asphalt paving, and landscaping
- Improvements to Cenotaph Park
- Some underground work will also take place on Park Lane and Princess Street West.
