

**By-law 30-2021**

**The Corporation of the Municipality of Central Huron**

**Being a By-law to Authorize the use of Telephone and Internet Voting as an Alternative Voting Method for the 2022 Municipal Election**

**Whereas** Section 42(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended states that the Council of a local municipality may pass a by-law to authorize electors to use an alternative voting method, that does not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote; and

**Whereas** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Huron deems it appropriate and in the public interest to conduct the 2022 Municipal Election using a Telephone and Internet voting method;

**Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Central Huron enacts as follows:**

1. That the Alternative Voting Method of Telephone and Internet Voting is hereby authorize for the Municipal Election to be held in 2022;
2. That By-law 3-2017 is hereby repealed;
3. This by-law shall come into effect upon final passing,

Read a first and second time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021.

Read a third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021.
