



Request for Quote for the supply and installation of a rubber, slip- resistant aquatic play area safety surface for an outdoor splashpad

The project will include removal of existing rubber surfacing and installation of approximately 1410 square feet of rubber surfacing at a thickness of 3/8 inches.

Responsibilities of the Awarded Bidder:

- Complete removal and disposal of existing rubberized surfacing at the Clinton Splashpad, located in the Clinton Community Park, 95 Park Lane, Clinton, On.
- Prepare the concrete base utilizing best practices and in accordance with Manufacturer's Preparation guidelines.
- Install 1407 square feet of poured in place, rubberized slip- resistant aquatic play area safety surface at a depth of 3/8 inches utilizing best practices and in accordance with Manufacturer's Installation recommendations.
- Supply all products required for the installation, repair and maintenance of the surface.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring all site conditions meet the requirements for installation.
- Work to be completed by August 21, 2026

Warranty:

- Warranty details and any exclusions are explicitly detailed in the proposal's submission.
- Bidder will provide maintenance training for municipal staff. Any warranty repairs are to be performed by qualified installers/technicians only.

Late Submissions:

Proposals received after the official closing time will not be considered during the selection process.

If electronic submissions are being accepted for this proposal, the onus is on Bidders to ensure their Electronic Bid Submission is received no later than the closing time and date stated. Bidders are cautioned that the timing of their bid submission is based on when the Bid is RECEIVED by the Municipality's Bidding System, not when a Bid is submitted by a Bidder, as Bid transmission can be delayed in an "internet traffic jam" due to file transfer size, transmission speed, etc. A Bid Submission will only be considered to have been submitted once it has been RECEIVED by the Municipality's Bidding System, regardless of when the Bid was submitted by the Bidder.

For the above reasons, the Municipality recommends that Bidders allow sufficient time to upload their Bid Submission and attachment(s), if applicable and to resolve any issues that may arise. The closing time and date shall be determined by the Municipality's Bidding System web clock.

Bidders should contact the Municipality at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closing time and date, if they encounter any problems. The Bidding System will send a confirmation email to the Bidder advising that their bid was submitted successfully.

Proponents are advised there will NOT be a public opening for this RFQ.
